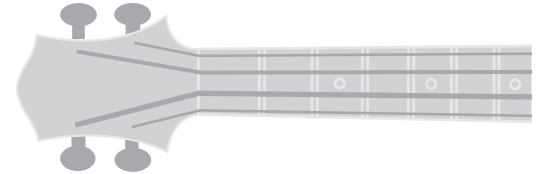

Open Position Chords in Common Keys

Chords with no open position voicing are shown as their movable form.



Seventh chords can show up in any key.

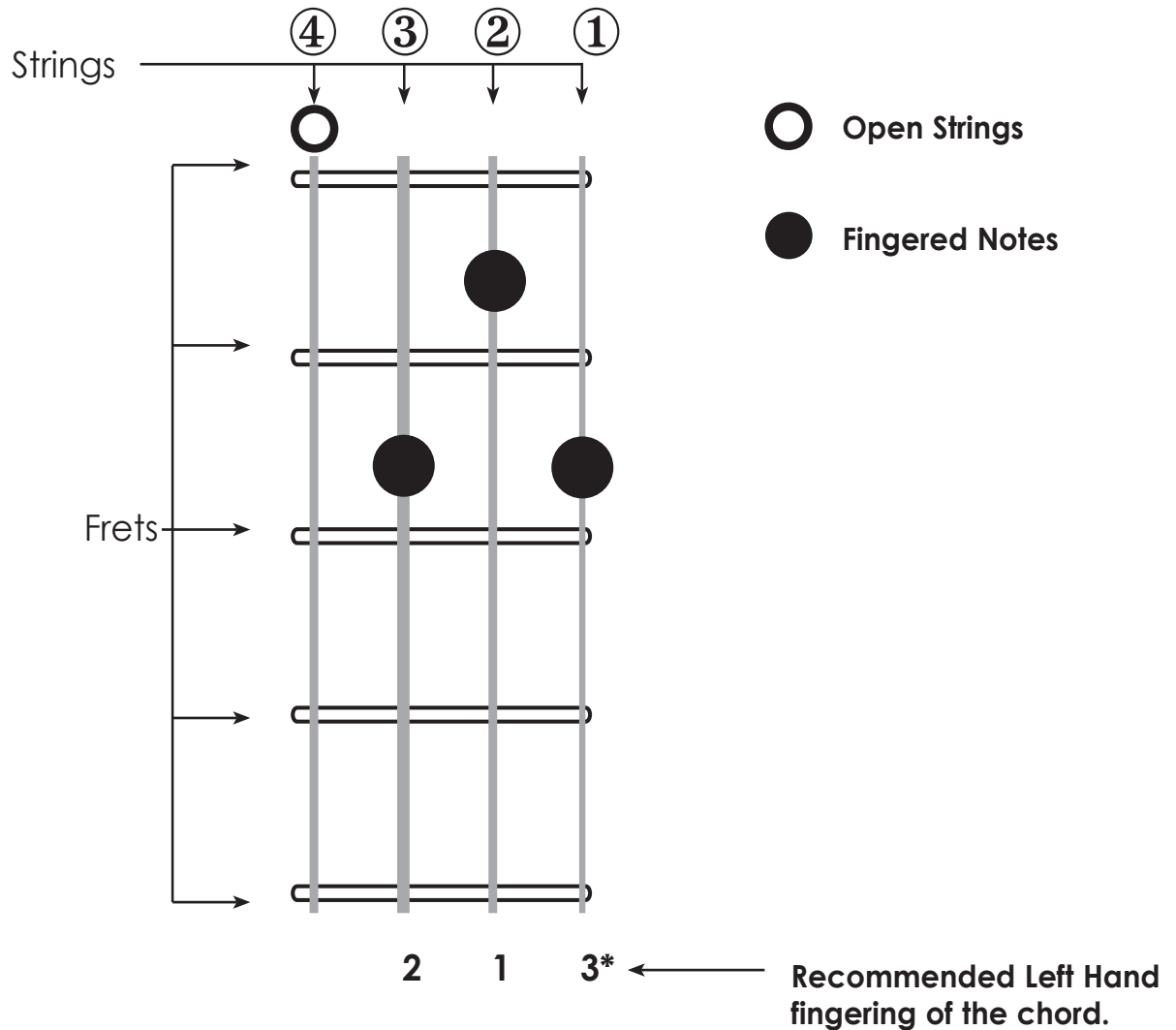
